- Write tricky words on paper and throw them around the garden. Call out a word. Child brings the word to you.
- Spread words out on the table. When you call out a word your child points to it.
- Put words in a magic bag. Child picks them out missing and reads them one by one.
- Put 4 words on the table and child reads them. Child closes eyes and you take one word away. Child guesses what word it is.
