Area Chosen for Review

Who undertook this review	Actions taken / Results obtained
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<p>Staffroom waste</p>	<p>Committee member</p>	<p>Green bin and landfill bin working well but still some unsuitable items being found in the compost bin. This may be due to visitors or substitute teachers who are not aware of how the bins operate.</p>
<p>Classroom bins</p>	<p>Children from committee</p>	<p>Recycling bins working very well. Less compostable waste in ordinary bins as children taking lunch waste home.</p>
<p>Waste paper from photocopying / fax room</p>	<p>Committee member</p>	<p>Very little waste. Teacher access code with paper counter working well.</p>

Landfill waste	Caretaker	Approximately one and a half bins going to landfill. All lunch wrappers recycled at home. Bi-monthly collection of green bins going well.
Staff Toilets	Teachers and cleaners	Hand dryer installed to do away with the need for paper towels.
School Grounds	Teachers / Parents / Children	Regular clean up days organized. Woodland area created on major black spot dumping area.
