

St Ronan's N.S Erasmus Policy for Student Selection Criteria:

The following policy contains the criteria for a student to be selected to go on a school Eramsus exchange programme abroad. This policy has been decided on by the Erasmus Committee and is subject to review and change.

- **1. Behaviour:** Students must exhibit good behaviour in school, adhering to school rules and regulations.
- **2. Responsibility and Maturity**: The students selected for the trip must demonstrate responsibility and maturity in their actions and decision-making in St.Ronans N.S.
- **3. Openness to New Experiences**: Students selected for the trip should show a willingness to embrace new experiences and engage with different cultures through everyday school life.
- **4. Parental Approval and Support:** Parental approval and support for staff and students is mandatory to participate in the Erasmus trip.
- **5. Passport Requirement:** Students must possess a valid passport or be willing to obtain one promptly. They should also be prepared to complete any necessary travel forms.
- **6. Independence:** Selected students should be able to display independence and the ability to manage themselves during the trip.

- **7. Positive Attitude:** Students selected must maintain a positive attitude towards school life and the opportunity to partake in the Erasmus trip.
- **8. Room Pairings:** Room pairings are crucial for the trip, it is essential that students paired together will get on and will be able to work and stay together.
- **9. Written or Oral Submission**: All students going on the trip must submit a written or oral piece explaining why they want to go on the trip and what it means to them.

All children that meet the criteria outlined above will be placed into a draw to be selected. Once selected and parental agreements have been signed, if a child withdraws from the trip parents will be required to pay €100 to make amendments to flight details
